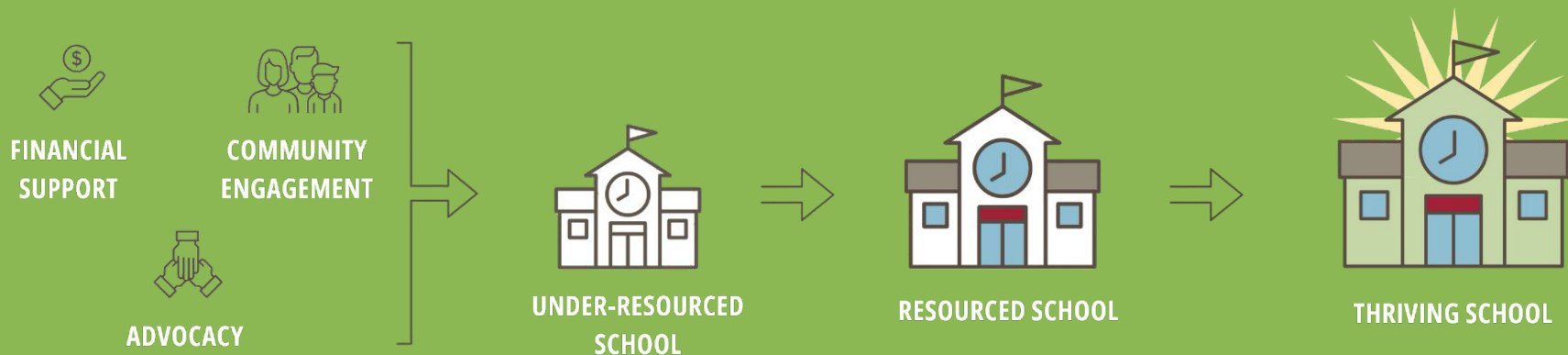

# Mission & Strategy

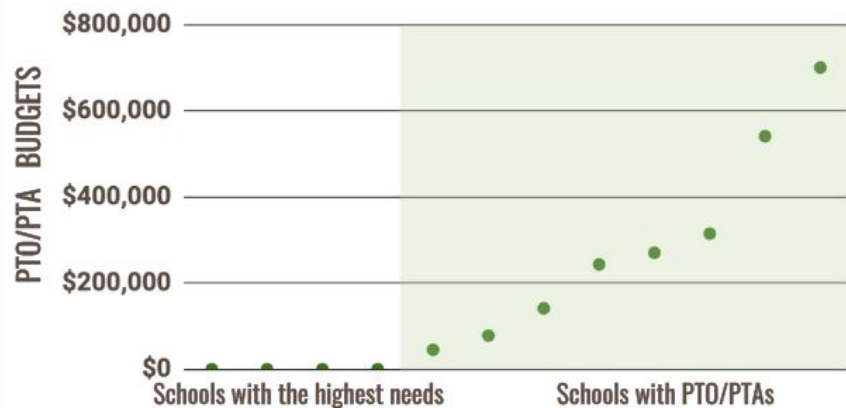
Cultivate community resources to promote equitable education, reduce barriers to engagement and increase the academic performance of underserved students in the Redwood City School District.

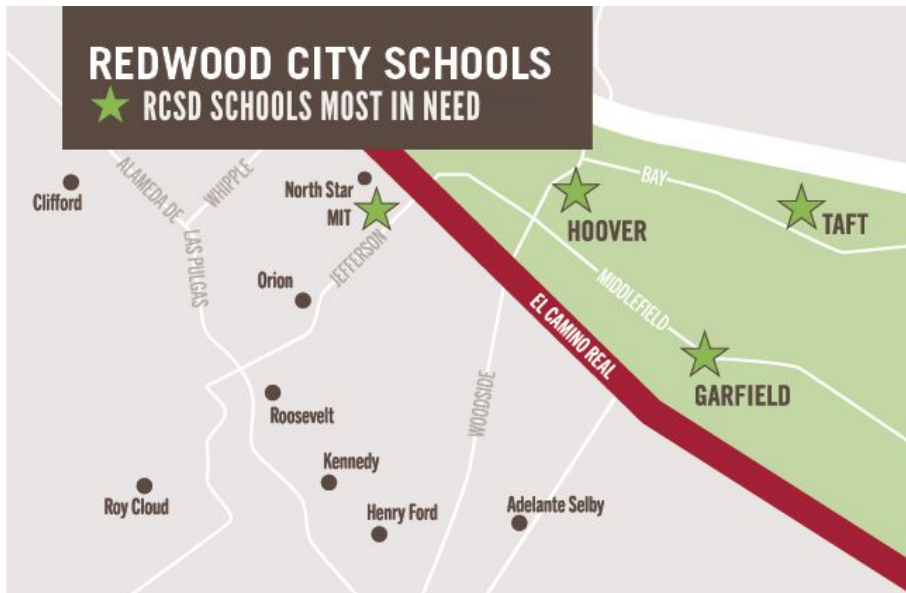
## FUNDRAISING ACROSS ALL RCSD SCHOOLS
